

How to apply?

NLD works in partnership with dozens of organizations and state/federal agencies. Many of our partners keep NLD applications on file for clients.

1. If incarcerated, ask your institutional PO for an application and request that they email it to us.
2. If you are in residential treatment for drugs or alcohol, when you are getting near graduation ask your counselor for an application. They can fax or email it directly to us.
3. If you are being referred by another organization or department, you can get the application from a case manager, Clinician, or PO and it can be emailed, faxed, sent via regular mail, or hand delivered directly to our main office.

5. In some cases we may request a face to face interview.

Residential Supportive Services Program

Facilities

New Life Development's main facility is located on the eastside of Anchorage in the Russian Jack Springs neighborhood. This 7,360 sq. ft. handicap accessible facility hosts up to 30 women.

New Life Development houses men in two separate facilities in Anchorage and can house up to 35 men per night.

Staff on duty or accessible 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

People Mover bus line #20 runs directly in front of the property along Bragaw Street, near Debarr.

Services

SOBER SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

New Life Development is a transitional supportive housing program for men and women who are homeless or in need of a clean and sober residential program. Rooms are fully furnished with a wide range of amenities such as free laundry, internet access, satellite tv, gym, free parking and meet spaces. We also provide various supportive services including case management, food and clothing support as well as placement support into permanent housing.

Substance Misuse Services

New Life Development offers a variety of groups, classes and material for program participants and the community, including a weekly AA and NA meetings. New Life Development is NOT a "low barrier" program/shelter. All applicants are required to be clean and sober at all times, while in the program.

SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

New Life Development provides regular activities for our residents to help them better acclimate back into society and learn to have fun and enjoy life without drugs and

Requirements

- ◆ Are homeless in need of a sober environment, or in need of DOC approved housing.
- ◆ If employable, participants must seek and gain employment within a reasonable amount of time.
- ◆ The ability to remain sober for the duration of the participation in the New Life Development program.
- ◆ Complete chores, attend mandatory meetings, respect the curfew and all other rules of the house.
- ◆ Commit to a minimum of 6 months in the program.
- ◆ The ability to pay program fees on a monthly basis.
- ◆ Program fees may be paid by a partner agencies, and when applicable, program fees may be partially subsidized.

Program Fees

Women's: \$700 a Month
Men's: \$700 a Month.

All fees are programmatic and not rent. NLD is not a landlord. NLD is a tightly structured residential program. All residents are program participants. All program participants are guests and can be discharged for violating program rules. If discharged, residency ends immediately.

Although New Life Development is a residential program, the housing is just one component of the program. Full Participation in all aspects of the program is a requirement.
