

To Transient sail boat owners

Starting on August 1st, 2015 we will no longer step transient masts from the deck of boats. We will only step and un-step masts that are stored and maintained over the winter at Rumery's.

The way this will work:

FALL - You arrive at Rumery's float ready to have the mast removed – you are welcome to loosen the turnbuckles a little, remove and stow the boom aboard, organize and tie up halyards and disconnect wiring where accessible. Rumery's crew will then un-step the mast, inspect the mast, standing & running rigging, remove the spreaders, organize and tie back the rigging and make a short inspection report. Rumery's will then place the mast on a storage rack for the winter.

The flat-rate charge for this will be \$1,100.

Any repairs required to the standing or running rigging or mast wiring and lights will be billed separately.

SPRING- Prior to your scheduled date for stepping Rumery's will remove your mast from storage, wash it, place the spreaders, test the lights, and organize the rigging for stepping. Rumery's will then step and tune the rig, pin the clevis pins and turnbuckles. Rumery's will connect wiring that is inside the base of the mast. Exterior wiring will be connected or not depending on your choice.

The flat-rate charge for this will be \$800 plus the cost of connecting wires.

This program allows us to better control our schedule and manage our liability on the waterfront.
