Narrative Description of Activities Go Mobile Assets Corporation

Go Mobile Assets Corporation is a veteran-led nonprofit organization based in the Merrimack Valley. The organization was founded by veterans, for veterans, and built from lived experience, compassion, and community strength. Our mission is to restore dignity, access, and connection for veterans who are navigating recovery, transition, or reintegration.

Our work begins with Mobility Support. Go Mobile Assets provides free valet assistance and non-emergency transportation services to veterans accessing medical care, treatment programs, and community services. Transportation services begin at the Bedford VA Medical Center and expand outward using a tiered model based on distance, frequency of need, and level of stability required.

The second core program area is Family & Community Reconnection. Veterans heal best when they remain connected to people and experiences that matter. The organization provides transportation support and coordination for meaningful life events such as family visits, school activities, celebrations, and community engagement outings. These experiences help restore trust, identity, and belonging.

The third core program area is Veteran & Family Education & Support. Go Mobile Assets provides peer-led and clinician-supported group sessions designed to strengthen communication, improve emotional resilience, and assist families and veterans in navigating stress, transition, and recovery. This program follows a phased development model: beginning with Peer Support Specialists, integrating graduate-level clinical interns under supervision, and expanding to licensed clinicians as program capacity grows.

All services are provided free of charge to veterans and their families. Go Mobile Assets operates with a commitment to Duty, Dignity, and Direct Action. Our work is grounded in integrity, community support, and the belief that every veteran deserves access to care, connection, and a path forward.
