SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PACKET AND GUIDELINES

The Knights of Columbus, Mt. Shasta Council #2599 grants scholarships to qualifying seniors from four south county parishes: Holy Family Parish in Weed, St. Anthony's Parish in Mt. Shasta, St. Joseph's Parish in McCloud and St. John's Parish in Dunsmuir. Those attending parochial schools or are home schooled are also eligible. Those attending public schools out of their home parish need to apply for scholarships at their school of attendance and are not eligible in their home parish.

This scholarship may be used for any school attendance related expense such as, books, tuition, room and board or registration.

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

- A. Be a practicing Catholic of one of the above named parishes.**
- B. Be in your final year of high school with eligibility for college/vocational program.**
- C. Have a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 throughout all of high school.**
- D. Intend to enroll at an accredited college or vocational school after graduation.**

HOW TO APPLY FOR A KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS SCHOLARSHIP

- 1. Complete items 1-5 on the front of the application.
- 2. Present the application to your principal (parent if home schooled) for completion of item 6.
- 3. Present the application to your pastor for completion of item 7.
- 4. When all items are completed return application to:
