BEFORE YOU PROCEED, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY, PAYING CLOSE ATTENTION TO “SPECIAL NOTES”:

YOU MUST BE AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF ST. MARON, YOUNGSTOWN TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

YOUR APPLICATION WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED UNLESS the Board has RECEIVED all of the following items by the Sunday announced from the altar and in the bulletin

1. A COMPLETED APPLICATION FORM (enclosed as pages 3-10 of this document):

- a. Application parts include Application for Scholarship (pages 3-5), Certification by Applicant (pages 7-8), Certification by Parent(s)/Guardian(s) (page 9), Personal Initialed Checklist (page 10).
- b. **SPECIAL NOTE**-If you need more room than what is provided on these pages, you may use the reverse side of the page or attach additional sheets.

2. PERSONAL ESSAY:

- a. **SPECIAL NOTE**: This is only required for graduating high school seniors
- b. Can be completed on page 6 of this document.
- c. Length should be approximately 200 words.

3. OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS:

- a. An official transcript of high school grades (or college if applicable) for the most recent grading period completed (not necessarily the current grading period), or the most recent available.
- b. The following constitutes an “official” transcript:
 - i. Generated by a high school or university administrator (i.e. Principal, Advisor, Counselor, etc.)
 - ii. Contains a formal signature of a high school or university administrator.
 - iii. An official school seal (unless indicated by the institution that they do not utilize a transcript seal).
 - iv. Transcripts must be in a sealed high school/university envelope when submitted with this application.
- c. **SPECIAL NOTE**: Self-generated computer printouts will NOT be accepted as official transcripts.
- d. **SPECIAL NOTE**: In order to assure that your transcripts are received on time, it is recommended that you place your transcript request with your high school/university at least two weeks prior to the application deadline.

4. A LETTER OF PERSONAL REFERENCE (i.e. Letter of Recommendation):

- a. **SPECIAL NOTE**: This is only required for first-time applicants (first time applicant means a student who has never been awarded a St. Maron’s Education Scholarship).
- b. Must be from someone with knowledge of your academic skills (i.e. a professor, teacher, academic advisor/counselor). This person must be from your current institution.
- c. The letter must be currently dated and signed as a separate attachment.

5. SAT OR ACT SCORES:

- a. **SPECIAL NOTE**: This is only required for graduating high school seniors
- b. “Official” ACT or SAT scores can be printed directly from ACT or SAT website, or can appear on your official high school transcript.
