#### **CONVERSION OF ST. PAUL**

On January 25th, the Church celebrates the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul, one of the most powerful examples of God's transformative grace. Saul of Tarsus was zealous in his



persecution of the early Christians, believing them to be enemies of God. Yet, on the road to Damascus, Saul encountered the risen Christ in a blinding light. Jesus' words, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" (Acts 9:4), pierced his heart, revealing that in persecuting Christians, he was persecuting Christ Himself.

Struck blind, Saul was led into the city, where he spent three days in prayer and fasting. Through Ananias, a disciple sent by God, Saul regained his sight, and was baptized. From that moment, Saul became Paul, spreading the message of Christ to the Gentiles and writing much of the New Testament. Paul's conversion is a testament to God's infinite mercy and the power of grace to transform even the most hardened sinner into a saint. It reminds us that no one is beyond the reach of God's love and that every life has the potential for profound renewal in Christ.


