THE HEALING OF THE HEMORRHAGING WOMAN

In the Gospel according to Mark, the hemorrhaging woman stands as an icon of every soul burdened by hidden wounds yet still daring to hope in the mercy of God.

For twelve long years, suggesting a fullness of suffering, she lived in quiet isolation, carrying a pain that separated her from others and from worship, much like humanity estranged from the joy for which it was created. Yet beneath her frailty burned a courageous faith. She believed that even the slightest contact with Christ would be enough. What is striking is that holiness in Jesus is not distant or easily threatened; it is living, radiant power. When she reached out and touched the hem of His garment, she did not contaminate Him, rather, His life flowed into her.

In a single moment, shame was transformed into dignity, and anonymity into relationship. Christ does not allow her to disappear back into the crowd; He turns, calls her forward, and names her "Daughter." In doing so, He reveals that miracles are not merely about physical healing but about restoration to communion. This Gospel invites us to examine our own hesitations: the fears that keep us at the edge of the crowd, the wounds we hide, the silent prayers we scarcely dare to voice. Like her, we are asked to trust that even a trembling reach toward Him is enough.

During this Lenten season, I humbly ask for your help in meeting our most urgent needs:


- Education and formation of our seminarians




ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

Last year, we set a goal of **\$260,000**, which was allocated as outlined below. We raised a little over the goal amount, which helped defray the expenses of printing and mailing the Eparchial Appeal. We are truly grateful to all who generously contributed to support our Eparchy.

REPORT ON 2025 LENTEN APPEAL USE OF FUNDS (\$260,000)

**The funds raised are not sufficient to fully cover the expenses in various areas. The Eparchy continues to provide subsidies and address additional costs as necessary.*



1. SEMINARIANS AND RETIRED PRIESTS



Our Eparchy is actively preparing two celibate seminarians and four married candidates for the Sacred Priesthood. Over the past year, the total expenses for their education, housing, formation, and living costs amounted to **\$283,618**. Additionally, we provide support for 10 retired priests, which incurs an annual cost of around **\$321,000**. **35% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will support Seminarians and Retired priests.**

2. MISSIONS AND AND SMALL PARISHES



Our Eparchy encompasses thirty-seven parishes and ten missions, serving over 46,000 Maronite Catholics across 34 states. Recently, we have established missions in New Orleans (LA) and Dallas (TX), as well as a plan to establish a new community in Mobile (AL). Many of these missions rely on financial assistance from the Eparchy to cover essential expenses. Your generous contributions will help us support these missions and connect with our cherished Maronite community throughout the country. **25% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will support Missions and Small Parishes.**

3. MINISTRIES



Our Eparchy plays a vital role in the lives of thousands of children, youth, and young adults, offering regional youth conferences and vibrant Catechism programs. Additionally, we have a thriving Family Life Ministry that works alongside our Subdiaconate and Diaconate Ministries. With these initiatives, the future of our Eparchy is looking very promising! **15% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will assist the Eparchy's Ministries.**

4. BASILICA AND NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF LEBANON



Established over 60 years ago, our Eparchy takes pride in serving as a spiritual home of renewal and rejuvenation for the faithful across the nation. We warmly welcome pilgrims and visitors throughout the year, with a special emphasis on the Assumption Pilgrimage in August. **10% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will assist the National Maronite Shrine.**

5. CHARITABLE OUTREACH



As our Eparchy encourages the faithful to be generous, we also commit ourselves to supporting those in need. We provide assistance to the less fortunate in the United States, Lebanon, and the Middle East.
