



BROTHER ESTEPHAN NEHME

was born in Lehfed, on March 8th, 1889. He was given the name of Youssef.

Youssef was the youngest among three boys and two girls and was pampered by everyone and the angel of the family. Since his childhood, Youssef loved God and holy Mother Mary. Youssef

was not sociable and he was not interested in parties, even among family. On the contrary, he preferred to stay at home and pray late at night. Afterwards, he went to bed and repeated: "God can see me, God can

see me. Jesus, Mary and Saint Joseph, help me at the moment of death."


When he was 16-year-old, Youssef left his parental house heading to the Monastery of Saints Cyprian and Justine in Kfifane in order to become

monk, and took the name of "Estephanos". Brother Estephan was a "worker monk" and spent 31-year monastic life. He worked in the fields and gardens of the monastery. He passed away on August 30th, 1938, at the age of 49 years old, due to a sunstroke. On December 17th, 2007, Pope Benedict XVI recognized Brother Estephan Nehme Venerable.

Brother Estephan was recognized Blessed on the altar of the Lord on June 27th, 2010 at the Monastery of Saints Cyprian and Justine in Kfifane, for the healing miracle attributed to him which is the healing of Sister Marina Nehmeh, his brother's daughter, from osteosarcoma (bone cancer).
