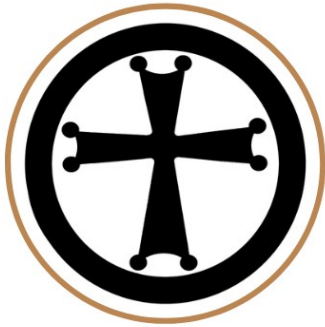
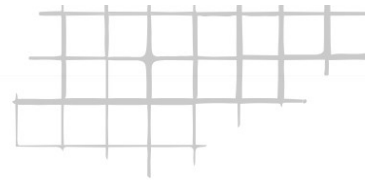

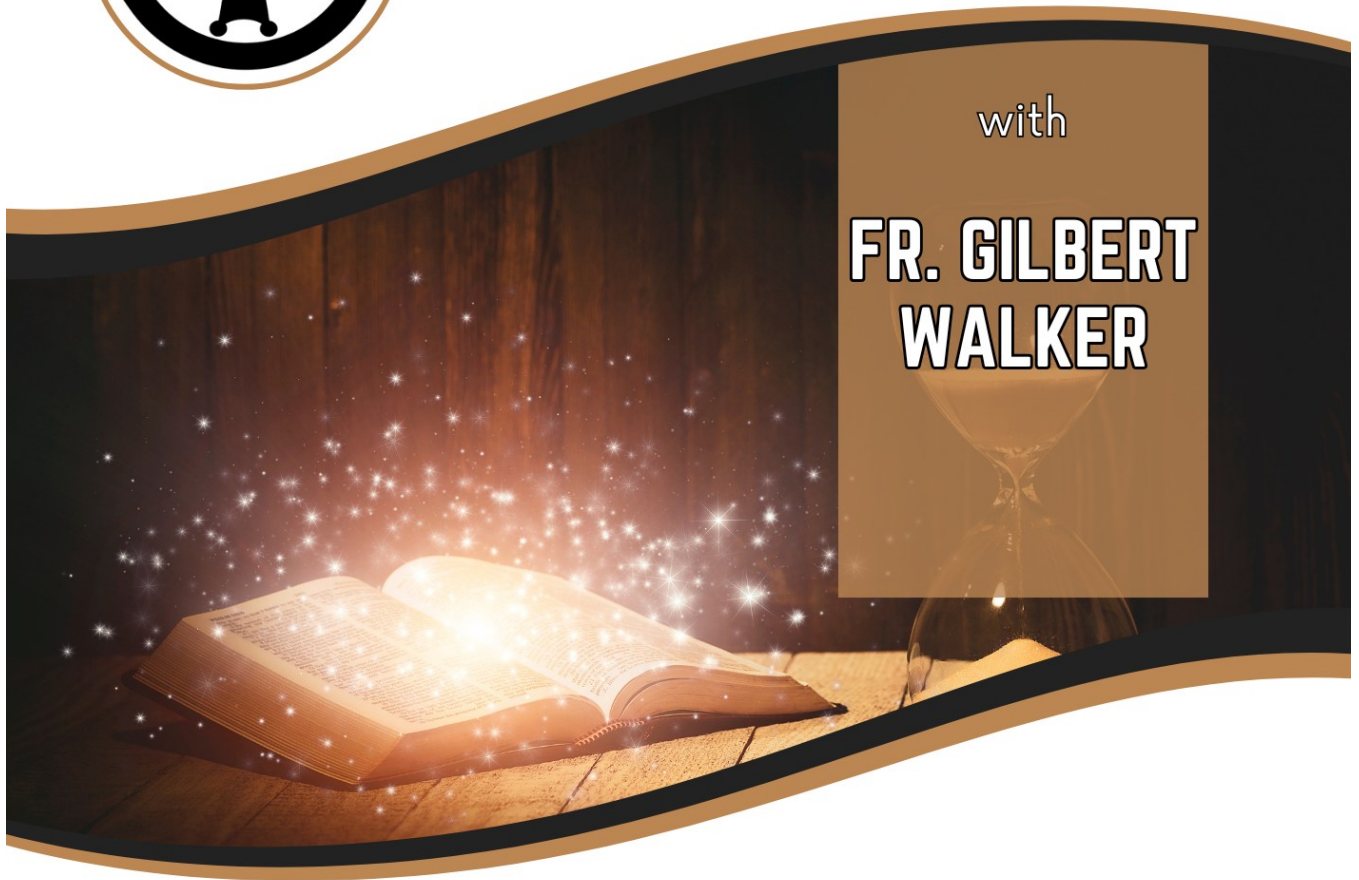

Dear Brother Priests:

We are blessed to have four newly ordained priests in 2025! Also, we have three seminarians and four married men currently preparing for the priesthood for the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon of Los Angeles. This is wonderful, but also presents a financial challenge, as it costs about \$50,000 per seminarian each year to educate and form these men.

The Order of Saint Sharbel has played an important role in helping to pay these expenses since the Order was founded over 40 years ago. Members of the Order also provide spiritual support, praying for seminarians and vocations, which is very important. The Order's Annual Membership dues help pay the current year's seminarian expenses. The Order's Perpetual Membership dues are put into an endowment fund, the interest on which is used to pay seminarian expenses.

The second Sunday of October (October 12, 2025) is designated as "Order of Saint Sharbel Sunday" in the Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon of Los Angeles as it is the closest date to the canonization of St. Sharbel on October 9, 1977 by Pope Paul VI. On October 12, I ask in each parish for a short (2-3 minutes) talk about the need for vocations and the importance of the Order, and a word of encouragement to the faithful to join. The talk can be given by you or by someone you designate.

It would also be helpful to assign a coordinator for the Order of Saint Sharbel in your parish. You may consult with local members of the Order on this. Please send me the name and contact information for the local coordinator if you have not already done so.

Please find enclosed several copies of the new Seminarian Poster for the 2025-26 academic year. I ask that you kindly put this poster in prominent places in the Church and Hall as soon as possible. Also enclosed are a few smaller copies of the poster, to duplicate and disseminate to your parishioners by mail, email, bulletin, the parish website and, if you have it, a Facebook page, and any other method you deem helpful. These have also been emailed to you. If you have any questions, please contact me or our Stewardship Director, John Kurey, at maroniteswest@yahoo.com.


