"Death was weeping for her, even Death, as he saw her who had given life to the dead, lying in the tomb. But He rose, He who is the Resurrection, and He made her rise with Him." Hymns on the Resurrection (Hymn 1:12)

This poetic quote from St. Ephrem helps to encapsulate the vision of the Resurrection in our Syriac theology. The Author of Life became himself death that, through it, He may bring us new life. To understand the profound gift our Lord and King Jesus Christ gives us through His Resurrection, we must take the time to contemplate and pray, focusing on the purpose of the Resurrection. We give to Christ our life, asking that through His grace and power, He lifts our hearts and souls in His glorious resurrection. To offer our life to our Lord is no small task. We must be willing to humble ourselves, our desires, our wants, our needs, and say the same words our Lord said in the garden of Gethsemane, "not my will, but your will."

St. Ephrem, in his Hymns on the Nativity (Hymn 4:31) wrote: "He gave Himself to the will of the Father, that the will of the enemy might be undone." The only way that we can fight the good fight against the Enemy, Satan, is by aligning our will with the will of the Father. This may sound like a lot of fluff or a bit abstract, but if we pause to think and ask God what He wants from us, we soon find He is calling us the same way He called our ancestors, the saints, all those in the Bible, He is calling us to pick up our cross and follow Him. Why? This is the only path to true freedom and peace. This is what we celebrate in the Glorious Resurrection. That the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the long-awaited Messiah by the prophets and people of old, became one of us to lead us to the Father. That we can know our Father and His love for us as we journey through this life, looking forward to the next with Him. Certain of God's love and friendship that whoever it is or whatever it is working against me, be it Satan or circumstances of life, that my trust and hope is in my Father who loves me and cares for me and with His love and care my cross is a little lighter and my journey easier to travel.

The Glorious Resurrection is our feast, the feast of the promise and covenant God made through His Son with us. As the Qolo from the Sunday of the Resurrection in our Liturgy book says, "God the Father sent his Son to make Adam's image new." Our life in Christ Jesus is renewed if we are willing to give it to Him. The light and joy that we long and hope for is found in Him and through Him. How does that help us today? In plain terms, God carries me and with Him on my side, no matter what happens in this life, I am His, and He will not let me go. I have a new life through Jesus' Resurrection. I have a new way of understanding the world. I have a new relationship with those around me. With the eyes of faith, I can see what was old is made new. All this is possible through God's grace, that we, made in His image and likeness, are made new again by His Resurrection.
