THE PRODIGAL SON

In the parable of the prodigal son (Luke 15:11-32), the true center of the story is not the son's rebellion but the father's relentless love.



The younger son's departure represents humanity's desire to live without dependence on God, yet even in his lowest moment, hungry and humiliated, remembrance becomes the beginning of redemption. His return is marked not by rehearsed apologies but by the father's interruption of mercy: before a word of explanation is completed, he is embraced, clothed, and restored.

The parable reveals that repentance is less about earning forgiveness and more about accepting a love that never ceased. The elder brother's struggle, however, warns us that it is possible to remain physically near the Father while spiritually distant. Ultimately, this Gospel invites us not only to return home, but to rejoice whenever grace restores another.

During this Lenten season, I humbly ask for your help in meeting our most urgent needs:


- Education and formation of our seminarians




ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

Last year, we set a goal of **\$260,000**, which was allocated as outlined below. We raised a little over the goal amount, which helped defray the expenses of printing and mailing the Eparchial Appeal. We are truly grateful to all who generously contributed to support our Eparchy.

REPORT ON 2025 LENTEN APPEAL USE OF FUNDS (\$260,000)

**The funds raised are not sufficient to fully cover the expenses in various areas. The Eparchy continues to provide subsidies and address additional costs as necessary.*



1. SEMINARIANS AND RETIRED PRIESTS



Our Eparchy is actively preparing two celibate seminarians and four married candidates for the Sacred Priesthood. Over the past year, the total expenses for their education, housing, formation, and living costs amounted to **\$283,618**. Additionally, we provide support for 10 retired priests, which incurs an annual cost of around **\$321,000**. **35% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will support Seminarians and Retired priests.**

2. MISSIONS AND AND SMALL PARISHES



Our Eparchy encompasses thirty-seven parishes and ten missions, serving over 46,000 Maronite Catholics across 34 states. Recently, we have established missions in New Orleans (LA) and Dallas (TX), as well as a plan to establish a new community in Mobile (AL). Many of these missions rely on financial assistance from the Eparchy to cover essential expenses. Your generous contributions will help us support these missions and connect with our cherished Maronite community throughout the country. **25% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will support Missions and Small Parishes.**

3. MINISTRIES



Our Eparchy plays a vital role in the lives of thousands of children, youth, and young adults, offering regional youth conferences and vibrant Catechism programs. Additionally, we have a thriving Family Life Ministry that works alongside our Subdiaconate and Diaconate Ministries. With these initiatives, the future of our Eparchy is looking very promising! **15% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will assist the Eparchy's Ministries.**

4. BASILICA AND NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF LEBANON



Established over 60 years ago, our Eparchy takes pride in serving as a spiritual home of renewal and rejuvenation for the faithful across the nation. We warmly welcome pilgrims and visitors throughout the year, with a special emphasis on the Assumption Pilgrimage in August. **10% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will assist the National Maronite Shrine.**

5. CHARITABLE OUTREACH



As our Eparchy encourages the faithful to be generous, we also commit ourselves to supporting those in need. We provide assistance to the less fortunate in the United States, Lebanon, and the Middle East.
