



GOSPEL OF THE WEEK

John 1:35-42 show us that in the Maronite tradition, this "remaining" reflects the call to dwell continually in God's presence through the Eucharist, prayer, and fidelity to the Church's living tradition.

Jesus' invitation, "Come and see," affirms that faith is born through encounter and experience, not mere instruction.

The Gospel then shows how encounter leads to mission: Andrew, transformed by his time with Christ, immediately seeks out his brother Simon and brings him to Jesus, reminding us that evangelization begins in the family and flows naturally from a heart touched by grace. When Jesus looks at Simon and gives him the new name Peter, He reveals His divine authority and His power to reshape human identity, calling forth strength and purpose where weakness once dwelled. In this passage, the Maronite Church hears a call to remain rooted in Christ, to allow His gaze to transform us, and to become living witnesses who invite others to "come and see" the joy of the Gospel.


