## THE HEALING OF THE PARALYTIC

The Gospel of the healing of the paralytic presents more than a miracle story; it reveals an encounter between human limitation and divine compassion. The paralytic himself speaks no words, performs no actions, and makes no visible request. His silence becomes significant. In a world that often values strength and independence, this man represents the vulnerability every person carries; moments when we cannot move forward spiritually, emotionally, or even physically on our own. At the center of this Gospel is Jesus' ability to see beyond appearances. While the crowd focuses on the physical condition of the man, Christ looks into the deeper reality of the heart. The paralysis becomes a symbol of spiritual stagnation; the ways fear, guilt, or discouragement can immobilize the soul. Before restoring movement to the body, Jesus restores freedom to the spirit, showing that true healing begins within. The crowded house also reflects the human condition: many gather around Christ, yet not all make room for those most in need. The breaking open of the roof becomes a powerful image of faith that refuses barriers. Sometimes healing requires opening what seems closed; hearts hardened by routine, expectations, or judgment; so that grace may enter. In the Maronite spiritual understanding, this passage reminds believers that Christ meets us precisely where we are unable to move. He approaches our helplessness not with condemnation but with mercy. The command, "Rise, take up your mat, and walk," is not only addressed to the paralytic but to every believer called to leave behind old burdens and step into renewed life. This Gospel invites us to recognize our own moments of paralysis and to trust that Christ continues to restore, strengthen, and send us forward. Healing becomes not merely the removal of suffering, but the beginning of a new relationship with God; one that transforms weakness into witness and stillness into mission.

During this Lenten season, I humbly ask for your help in meeting our most urgent needs:


- Education and formation of our seminarians




# ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

Last year, we set a goal of **\$260,000**, which was allocated as outlined below. We raised a little over the goal amount, which helped defray the expenses of printing and mailing the Eparchial Appeal. We are truly grateful to all who generously contributed to support our Eparchy.

## REPORT ON 2025 LENTEN APPEAL USE OF FUNDS (\$260,000)

*\*The funds raised are not sufficient to fully cover the expenses in various areas. The Eparchy continues to provide subsidies and address additional costs as necessary.*



## 1. SEMINARIANS AND RETIRED PRIESTS



Our Eparchy is actively preparing two celibate seminarians and four married candidates for the Sacred Priesthood. Over the past year, the total expenses for their education, housing, formation, and living costs amounted to **\$283,618**. Additionally, we provide support for 10 retired priests, which incurs an annual cost of around **\$321,000**. **35% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will support Seminarians and Retired priests.**

## 2. MISSIONS AND AND SMALL PARISHES



Our Eparchy encompasses thirty-seven parishes and ten missions, serving over 46,000 Maronite Catholics across 34 states. Recently, we have established missions in New Orleans (LA) and Dallas (TX), as well as a plan to establish a new community in Mobile (AL). Many of these missions rely on financial assistance from the Eparchy to cover essential expenses. Your generous contributions will help us support these missions and connect with our cherished Maronite community throughout the country. **25% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will support Missions and Small Parishes.**

### 3. MINISTRIES



Our Eparchy plays a vital role in the lives of thousands of children, youth, and young adults, offering regional youth conferences and vibrant Catechism programs. Additionally, we have a thriving Family Life Ministry that works alongside our Subdiaconate and Diaconate Ministries. With these initiatives, the future of our Eparchy is looking very promising! **15% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will assist the Eparchy's Ministries.**

### 4. BASILICA AND NATIONAL SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF LEBANON



Established over 60 years ago, our Eparchy takes pride in serving as a spiritual home of renewal and rejuvenation for the faithful across the nation. We warmly welcome pilgrims and visitors throughout the year, with a special emphasis on the Assumption Pilgrimage in August. **10% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will assist the National Maronite Shrine.**

### 5. CHARITABLE OUTREACH



As our Eparchy encourages the faithful to be generous, we also commit ourselves to supporting those in need. We provide assistance to the less fortunate in the United States, Lebanon, and the Middle East. Many religious institutions rely on our support to fulfill their basic needs and continue their ministries dedicated to helping the poor. **15% of this year's Annual Appeal proceeds will go to charity.**

Generally speaking, taxpayers who are age 70½ years old and older may give up to \$108,000 each year from their IRA to the Eparchy without paying the mandatory tax on IRA distributions.
