
Our crab is caught locally and freshly prepared by Filey fish merchant H G Lovitt.

Our fresh free range eggs are provided by Winkfield Farm.



Welcome to The Lighthouse Tea Room.

Janet and Paul acquired Anna's Tea Room in September 2007 and re-opened as The Lighthouse (the only themed tea room in Filey) in March 2008. In February 2017, Janet's son Simon and partner Emma took over the reins of the Lighthouse, upholding the character and legacy built up by Janet and Paul over the previous ten years. We hope that you find your visit an enjoyable and interesting experience.

There are over 200 lighthouses from around the world represented in one form or another. Try counting them! Almost all of the photographs were taken by Paul.

The lighthouse on our shop front is Cape Hatteras, North Carolina. It stands at 198ft tall. In 1999 it was moved 2900ft away from the edge of the sea and is well known for this feat of engineering and for its distinctive spiral pattern.

Our local lighthouse is Flamborough Head. It stands at 86ft tall, the light has a range of 24 nautical miles and its signal pattern is four flashes every 15 seconds.

The Flamborough Head Lighthouse acts as a waypoint for passing deep sea vessels and coastal traffic, and marks the headland for vessels heading towards Scarborough and Bridlington. The first lighthouse on Flamborough Head was built by Sir John Clayton in 1669, but never lit. The present lighthouse, designed by Samuel Wyatt and costing £8,000 to build, was first lit on 1 December 1806. The current electric fog signal was installed in 1975, replacing older equipment. In the past, warnings in foggy weather were provided by rockets, discharged every five minutes and reaching an altitude of 600 feet. The last lighthouse keepers left on 8 May 1996. Trinity House operate seasonal tours of the lighthouse.
