PMPOA Board Accomplishments For 2021-2022 Season

Fiscal Responsibility

- Ended fiscal year with modest surplus
- Contributed yearly Gate Emergency Reserve Fund Holding in line with 5-year plan
- Collected all outstanding annual dues except for two long-term deficit accounts that involved
 the deaths of the property owners and no clear indication of heirs (county tax office has also
 declined to pursue outstanding tax amounts)

Road Maintenance Responsibility

- Completed Road Maintenance within budget despite substantial raises in gravel and hauling
 - Completed culvert cleanouts
 - o Performed brush cutting and tree limb removal in targeted areas
 - Made substantial improvements in PRSPOA road base in switchbacks prior to the termination of the Road Agreement with PRSPOA
- Replaced and repaired (twice) parabolic mirror due to incurred weather-related damages
- Promptly addressed situations with fallen trees and snow emergencies (with help of volunteers)
- Organized a volunteer cleanup/landscaping day for the front entrance
- Provided new spotlights to illuminate the Pinnacle Mountain sign at the base of the community (volunteer funded)
- Refreshed planter and bases of stone walls with new mulch (volunteer funded)
- Performed kudzu spraying on select areas along Pinnacle Lane (volunteer funded)

Regulatory and Administrative Responsibility

- Enacted new regulations for fire burning
 - Purchased sign to post on current signage at base of mountain when Forestry Service enacts a fire ban
- Decommissioned old PMPOA website and redesigned the site on updated software
 - o Improved tiling of page and added content
- Held quarterly Board Meetings as per requirement
 - o Posted meeting and committee minutes in a timely fashion on the web site
- Performed all gate maintenance and reconciled two gate-related incidents
- Enhanced the communications cadence for community members for greater transparency
- Posted New Neighbor document on web site for new residents that answers most frequently asked questions

Agenda Items for Incoming Board

- Achieve solution for installation of new requested mailboxes at the base of the mountain
- Finalize the proposed new Road Agreement with PRSPOA
- Initiate project to remark Pinnacle Mountain property boundaries for non-hunting
- If passed in budget, schedule a larger Kudzu spraying effort for most intense concentrations
