# Arisaig Community Trails Association (ACT-A)

ACT-A received a **grant** from Antigonish County Recreation in the amount of \$895.00 to be used for clearing damage from Hurricane Fiona on the Snowmoon loop (trailhead located off Highfield Road). We hope to have this loop cleared and signage installed for the summer season.

Antigonish will be hosting a **provincial Hiking Summit** this year from **June 2-4th**. There are numerous hikes and events scheduled around the county and Arisaig has two featured routes: The Eiggman Loop and Arisaig Park.

#### News From the Friends of the Park

In park news, we've been busy preparing for the upcoming season!

The Parks team has **removed saleable fiber** from the brush and placed the remaining material into piles in preparation for mulching.We're excited to share that **repairs to the stairs** leading to the beach at the falls are currently underway and they will be open for use soon. **Gravel is on site** for when the trails dry up, so we can begin spreading it with machinery.

To ensure visitor safety, we're applying rolled roofing to the **boardwalk leading to the upper look-off.** This will provide a sturdy surface for walking and prevent any slips or falls.

We are still reviewing the replacement of three picnic table shelters and we have **repaired and painted 14 picnic tables and 2 benches,** with few more tables and benches still to complete.

Lastly, we plan to place **signage at the park entrance** to explain the damage caused by hurricane Fiona and our plans to repair the park. We look forward to seeing you at the park soon!
