



Jim Barrett Scholarship Award Rules



Origin

The Jim Barrett Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in March, 2001 by CWA Local 3122 to honor the name and memory of the man who served as President and Executive board member for many years. Jim Barrett took great pride in the role he played in our Local as a leader and in the field of education and other areas of social concern.

Rules and Regulations

Members, legal dependents, and grandchildren of CWA Local 3122 members (active or retired) may apply. Applicants must have graduated High school, or have a high school equivalent by the award date, and be enrolled full time in an accredited College / University for the following fiscal school year. Any winner who does not use his or her scholarship during the next fiscal school year will forfeit the scholarship unless he/ she appeals in writing to the Executive Board/ Membership for approval of an extension. NOTE: Fiscal School year for this next award is 2025-2026. **PRIOR WINNERS MAY REAPPLY!**

Scholarship

Two (2) \$1000.00 awards will be given each year to winning applicants from the Local. This year, winners will be announced at our September General membership meeting.

Dates

Applications are accepted during the dates of **August 1st, 2025, through August 30th, 2025**. Applications will be accepted through **US POSTAL SERVICE ONLY** and must be postmarked no later than **August 30th, 2025**.

Selections

Winners will be chosen by a lottery drawing at the September membership meeting. Only winners will be notified. The member and/or student shall receive their scholarship check at the next membership meeting they attend after the winners have been selected and provide CWA Local 3122 with their Student Id and Registrar office phone number of the College/University they will be attending.

Study Requirements

No specific studies are required. Scholarship winners may pursue what ever courses they wish.

Funding

The Jim Barrett Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by Local Funds that were approved by the membership during the June 2001 General Membership Meeting.
