4. Be able to prepare and calibrate a hand-held pedestrian applicator (Criteria 4.1 – 4.6)
5. Be able to operate the application equipment (Criteria 5.1 – 5.4)
6. Know how to carry out post-operational procedures (Criteria 6.1 – 6.3)
