Overview

This accredited course is ideal for construction sector staff who operate standard reach 360° excavators in their working role. Candidates will gain an understanding of how the 360° excavators function and will also learn how to control them safely and legally. The training is tailored to the size and weight of the candidate's equipment and can be delivered to suit their experience level.

Outline of Programme

- Introduction and explanation.
- Relevant legislation: LOLER 98, PUWER 98, Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, Operator Safety Code.
- Safety: pre-operational checks, end of use checks, attachments.
- Understanding: stability, capacity, motive and hydraulic controls.
- Operation: excavation, load and unload excavator on to/off of lorry, trailer, etc. manoeuvring in open/confined areas and on various terrains, quick hitch, lifting and positioning loads, unloading, transporting and setting up excavator, refuelling and charging.
- Theory and practical assessments.

Assessment

The Standard Reach 360° Excavator course is delivered between 2 and 10 days and an accredited certificate will be awarded upon completion. Candidates must demonstrate a willingness to learn in both theoretical and practical training and are expected to interact in group activities. Candidates should inform their trainer if they have any problems with reading and writing.

Important Information

- The training venue should be quiet and undisturbed.
- Staff should not be expected to be on duty.
- Staff attending should remain for the entire length of the session.
- Maximum of 3 staff per course.
