LITURGICAL REFLECTION

When the faithful adore Christ present in the Sacrament, they remember that this presence derives from the Sacrifice of the Mass and has as its purpose both sacramental and spiritual communion. Prayer before Christ the Lord sacramentally present in the reserved Eucharist extends the union with Christ that the faithful have reached in the reception of Holy Communion at Mass. Prayer before the Blessed Sacrament renews the covenant that in turn moves the faithful to maintain by their way of life what they have received through faith. There is great spiritual strength in placing oneself prayerfully in the presence of the reserved Sacrament.
