According to the 1992 USCCB Pastoral Letter, “Stewardship, a Disciple’s Response,” a steward is: “One who receives God’s gifts gratefully, cherishes and tends them in a responsible and accountable manner, shares them in justice and love with others, and returns them with increase to th the Lord.” The Pastoral Letter points out that “stewardship is an expression of discipleship”; it is not an option for Catholics.
