
- 1. Click the ^ next to Stop Video. Click "Choose a Virtual Background"




Parts of the Facebook Profile Page

- Timeline- Your Timeline is where you can see your posts or posts you've been tagged in displayed by date.
- Home Page- Your home page is what you see when you log into Facebook. It includes your News Feed, the constantly updating list of posts from friends, Pages and other connections you've made.
- About- Lists information about you
- Friends- Shows all your Friends
- **Photos** Displays all your photos
- Cover Photo- A cover photo is the larger photo at the top of your profile
- Profile Photo- Your current profile picture and cover photo are <u>public</u>, so they can be seen by anyone on or off Facebook.




If a friend comments on your status update, or comments on a post after you have done so, you'll be notified in the top-right-hand menu by your notifications button lighting up.



HOW TO LIKE A COMMENT OR PHOTO

Important Instagram Terminology

Username: Your username is how people recognize you on Instagram. When creating your account, you should be prompted to create a username. The name you choose follows the @ symbol and can include numbers, letters, periods and underscores.


Profile: Your Instagram profile is where you tell people who you are and what you like to post. When you click on the option "Edit your profile," you can add your name as the heading of your bio and write whatever else about yourself you would like

Post: Posts are the photos and videos you choose to share on Instagram.

Hashtag: Hashtags are used to give context to your post or comment.


Direct Message: Direct Message lets you send other accounts' posts and personal messages to as many people as you would like. To share another user's post, simply press on the paper airplane symbol and choose which profiles or group you want to send to. You may also include a message along with whatever you send.














Getting started with WhatsApp

WhatsApp is a cross-platform messaging app for smartphones that allows you to send text messages and make voice calls using your phone's Internet connection. In addition to sending texts, you can send pictures, videos, documents, and voice messages.

Everything sent via WhatsApp is protected with **end-to-end encryption**, meaning no one else can read or listen to your messages or calls aside from you and the recipient. Best of all, it's completely free to use. All you need is an Internet connection.





Text messaging

Now that you've downloaded WhatsApp and created an account, you're ready to start sending messages, photos, and more.


In order to message someone, that person will need to **be in your phone's contacts** and will need to also have a **WhatsApp account**.

You'll also need an **Internet connection** of some kind, whether it's through your cellular network or a Wi-Fi connection.


When you open WhatsApp, the **Chats** pane appears by default. On this pane, you'll be able to see all of your **recent**







To begin a conversation, you can either tap someone's **name** or tap the **pen/paper icon** in the top-right corner of the screen and select a contact.



The chat interface



Text Bar

Tap the **text bar** to bring up your keyboard. From here, you can type messages and send them.

Take Photo or Video

Tap the **take photo or video** icon to take a photo or video or to send photos from your library.

Voice Message Button

Hold down the **voice message** button to record a
voice message. Release the
icon when you're done and
the voice message will be
sent.

Back Button

Tap the **back** button to return to the **chats** pane and view all of your other conversations.

Forward Button

Tap the **forward** button to forward a photo or document to another person.

Send Media Button

Tap the **send media** button to share documents, your location, or contacts with someone. You can also take a picture or video from here, as well as send pictures and videos from your library.



Call

Tap the **call** button to start a voice call with someone. If the contact doesn't answer, you can leave a **voice message**.

Conversation

This is where your conversation will be displayed, including any messages, photos, documents, and more that you've sent and received.

Read Receipt Icon

The **read receipt** icon will appear once the recipient has opened and read your message. If there is no icon shown, this means the person has not yet read your message; the contact also may have read receipts disabled.


MAKE A WHATSAPP VIDEO CALL (iPhone/Android)



In addition to sending text messages, you can use WhatsApp to make video or voice calls. Because calls are made over the Internet, there will be no charges made or minutes used by your cellular plan. However, if you're not connected to a Wi-Fi network, voice calls will use up data from your data plan.

To start a **video or voice call**: There are a few easy ways to make voice calls. Open the conversation of the person you'd like to call and tap the **call** button in the top-right corner of the screen.

Tap the Name of the Contact at the top of the screen. You will see the text, video or phone icon under the Contact's picture.

















Incoming Video or Voice calls

To answer an incoming call:

When someone calls you via WhatsApp, it will either look like when you receive a regular phone call, or if you are in WhatsApp, it will display the contact. Depending on your phone it will vary.




