MY STORY

AN HONORABLE WOMAN OF THE CENTURY:

Alice Mae Carrington was born on October 14, 1916 to The late John "Doug" and Rosetta Gipson Carrington, in The Town of Shepherd, Texas.

Alice was baptized at the age of 8 years old in the Creek near Lake Pool Baptist Church in Shepherd, Texas.

Her rearing was filled with many traditions, experiences; morals; values; solid work ethics and mandates that were the perfect formula for the makings of a true Matriarch, Elder, Icon, Leader, Servant, and Vessel.

Alice met and married the love of her life, Benjamin Samuel "B.S." Wright, January 1st, 1940. Their union produced a Most Beloved Daughter, Rosetta Wright, on November 29, 1954.

Their Lineage continued with the birth of Grandson Latherio Wright; Great-Granddaughters: the late Naryssa Wright and Natalia Wright; and Great-Great- Granddaughter's Paisley Wright and Kai Williams.

During her early years, after graduating high school, Alice worked as a Maid & Cook. Her most esteemed roles being Wife, Mother and Homemaker. Alice has resided in Historic Kashmere Gardens for well over half her life, dating prior to construction of Houston's Renowned Interstate 610 Loop and is certainly regarded as a Pillar of the Community and City of Houston. In 1967 she faced the greatest challenge of her life, as she parted ways and said goodbye to her husband and soulmate when he passed away.

Alice has devoted her life and wisdom to many worthy causes through her unwavering commitment and impeccable leadership to various Religious Organizations, most notably: Pleasant Grove Baptist Church and New Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Houston, Texas for all her adult life.

Her dedication and leadership spans for decades through the following Organization Affiliations: Ollie Douglas Group; Lake Pool Cemetery Board of Directors; Longshoreman Committee; Willing Workers Mission; Naomi's Circle and Founder of Gipson Reunion Committee to name a few. Heroine Alice Mae Wright was a member of the Pearly Gate Court Number 98- Heroines of Jericho, where she faithfully served for over 80 Years as Senior Matron and Most Ancient Matron.

Alice Mae Wright will be forever mourned by all who were blessed to have known her.
