Rodeo Ground Rules:

- 1 GROUND RULES: Only actual contestant and one companion allowed gate access with wristband obtained at check-in.
- 2 ALL EVENTS - The "30-hour replacement" policy will be in effect. See Rodeo Entry Information page of the business journal.
- 3 ALL EVENTS - The "walk-up replacement" policy will be in effect. See Rodeo Entry Information page of the business journal.
- 4 ALL EVENTS - Re-entries will be accepted for available positions on Mon., April 7 between 9 AM and 11 AM. See Rodeo Entry Information page of the business journal.
- 5 TRADE DEADLINE - Fri., April 4 at 4 PM. All confirmed trades will be final and will be processed immediately after both involved parties have confirmed through PROCOM.
- 6 TE - If a timed event animal escapes during a performance or a re-run is awarded for any other reason during a performance, the extra will be used. Only escaped animals go back into the herd.
- 7 TR - Both ropers will come from the same box. Score will be 20 to 25 feet with an electric eye barrier.
- 8 TD, SW, TR - Two go-rounds.
- 9 QUALIFICATIONS: BB, SB - 30 minimum entries. No compensation. No slack. There may be two sections.
- 10 BR - 40 minimum entries. No compensation. No slack. There may be two sections in performances.

***** POST AT RODEO - REQUESTED BY COMMITTEE - NOT ENFORCED BY THE PRCA. *****

- 1 *POST: Portable pens are allowed as long as they are no bigger than 10x12. Stalls are available for \$20 per night. Call Dan 209.614.5072.*
- 2 *POST: Park in designated areas. All fire lanes are to be kept clear at all times.*
- 3 *POST: No smoking behind bucking chutes.*
