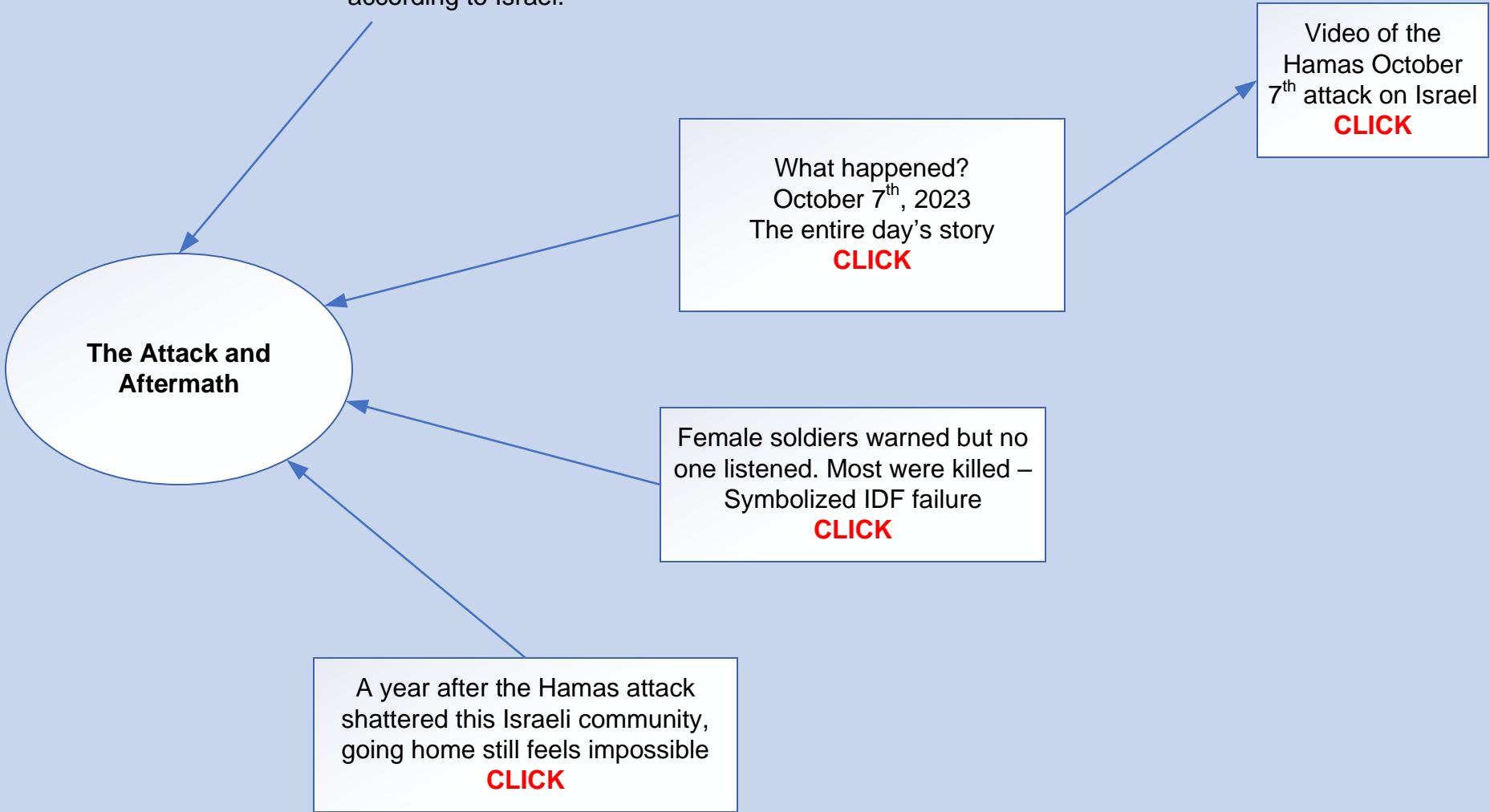
Killed on October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023

On October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023, Hamas killed over 1,250 Israelis and foreign nationals, including children and women.

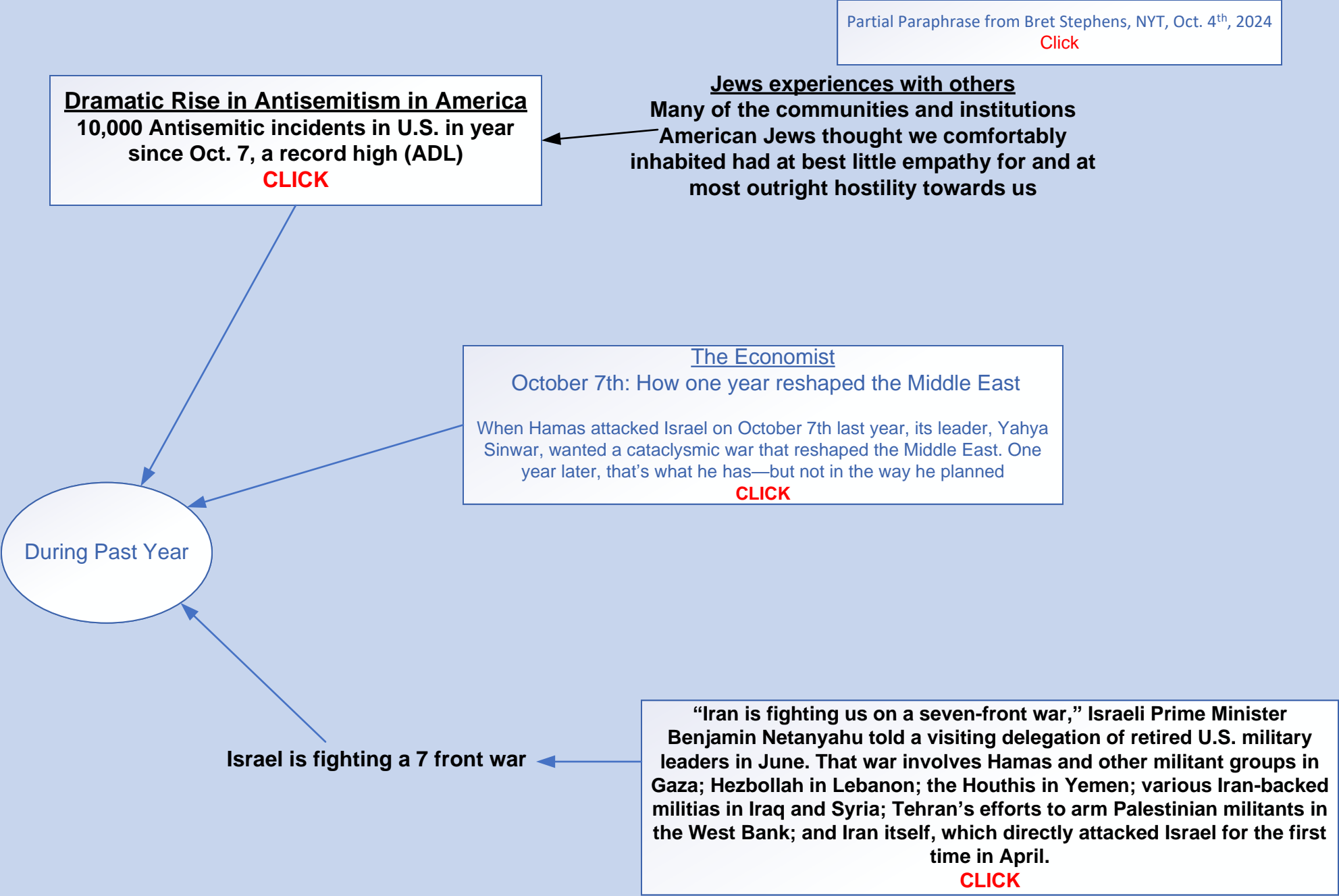
Hostages

More than 250 Israelis and foreigners were abducted and taken to Gaza, including many women and children.

72 hostages were reportedly killed on October 7 or in Hamas captivity according to Israel.
