ZERO WASTE STREAM


Rock Canyon Oil takes great pride in that we operate as a zero waste stream facility. Our equipment first removes water and light fuel components. Then, the de-watered oil is purified and separated into base oil with a small volume of re-refined fuel. The heaviest oil remains with dirt, contaminants and



spent additives. This becomes an asphalt extender oil used in asphalt paving projects. The recycling loop is closed when our base oil is blended with new additives for use in hydraulic oils, passenger car motor oil and other industrial oils. Rock Canyon Oil is pleased to provide the highest level of environmental stewardship regarding the responsible management of used oil.

PERMITTING, LICENSING & INSURANCE

Rock Canyon Oil currently holds three permits as issued the State of Utah Department of Environmental Quality, Used Oil Division. As a Used Oil Transporter, Used Oil Marketer and Used
