#### Record Breaking 2023 Sri Krishna Janmashtami Celebrations



"Janma karma ca me divyam evam yo vetti tattvatah" - The Lord's appearance is not like that of an ordinary human being, who is forced to accept a material body. He appears out of His own sweet will.

For the first time in Pittsburgh, a huge celebration was conducted on the actual day of Janmashtami, the appearance day of Lord Sri Krishna. Over 650 people attended this day-long event.

The Venango Trails Clubhouse was transformed into a Radha Krishna temple on September 6th. The festivities began at 5.00 am with a typical temple schedule for arti's and bhoga offerings including Mangal Arti, Japa Meditation, Sringara Darshan, Raj Bhoga Arti. The evening festivities started at 4.30 pm with cultural activities performed by the children which included singing of bhajans, devotional dance performances and sloka recitation.

The highlight of the event was that all participants got the opportunity to perform heartfelt loving Abhishek to the deities of Sri Sri Radha Krsna. A total of 108 food items were prepared by many families and offered to the Lord. The evening arti and kirtan was enjoyed thoroughly by all after which sumptuous dinner prasadam was served. Prayerful kirtans were chanted until midnight leading into the climax of the day, the midnight arti, celebrating the appearance of the Lord. Devotees who fasted till midnight then broke their fast.

The appearance of Krishna brings about all auspiciousness in the world and in the lives of










