Course #	Course Title	Instructor
1056	Survey of Jonah	Rev. Carl White
Study the Old Testament prophetic book that emphasizes God's love for all people-pagans and Gentiles, as well as His chosen people. Learn the message of salvation and its availability for all people		
1112	Survey of Revelation	Rev. Albert F. Mickel
This course will explore the book of Revelation, with emphases on authorship, date, theme, and recipients. Discuss the prophetic themes, symbols, and interpretations of various revelations		
2002	Nurturing New Converts	Rev. Dr. Perry Jones
Assist leaders in their responsibility for guiding and instructing new converts. Students will discover the most effective methods to nurture new members on personal Christian growth and development.		
2018	The Educational Task of the Church	Rev. Carl Lewis
Concentrate on the various educational ministries of the local church and focus on the unique role each ministry plays in the attainment of the total educational goals of the local church. Emphasis will be placed on the responsibility of each Christian to participate in the Christian education activities of the church.
