RING A - OPEN HACK RING any age - 8:00am to 12pm

Riders are not permitted to complete in more than one Hack Ring (except for the Led classes [1, 2, 3 & 4]

- 104. Led Horse 4 years & under Champion & Reserve Led Hack winner classes 1, 2, 3 & 4
- 105. Best Presented under 17 yrs
- 106. Best Presented 17 yrs & over
- 107. Junior Rider under 17 yrs
- 108. Senior Rider 17 yrs over

If you compete in class 10,11,12 you are not eligible to compete in class 14 & 15 or vice versa, you must choose to compete either as a Show Hack or Show Hunter. 5] & the Combined ring)

- 109. Show Pony under 14hh
- 110. Show Galloway 14hh 15hh
- 111. Show Hack over 15hh
 Champion & Reserve Hack winner of classes 10, 11 & 12 second place winners
 to standby for reserve

If you compete in class 10,11,12 you are not eligible to compete in class 14 & 15 or vice versa, you must choose to compete either as a Show Hack or Show Hunter. 5] & the Combined ring)

- 113. Show Hunter over 15hh
 Champion & Reserve Hunter winner of classes 14 & 15, second place winners to
 standby for reserve
- 114. Pleasure Hack

RING B - JUNIOR HACK / ENCOURAGE RING

under 17yrs - 8:30am to 12pm to commence after led classes in open ring

Classes can be split at discretion of judge depending on competitors ability, (ie riders who are on lead, coming off lead or those who cannot canter confidently in an open area.)

Riders are not permitted to complete in more than one Hack Ring (except for the Led classes [1,2,3,4 & 5] & the Combined ring)

- 119. Best Presented Mount & Rider 10 yrs & under 13yrs
- 120. Best Presented Mount & Rider 13yrs & under 17yrs
- 121. Rider on Lead must remain led for the day
- 122. Rider under 10 yrs
- 123. Rider 10 yrs & under 13 yrs
- 124. Rider 13yrs & under 17 yrs
- 125. Pony Hack under 14hh
- 126. Galloway Hack 14hh 15hh
- 127. Hack over 15hh Champion & Reserve Hack
- 128. Best Combination under 14hh (pony and rider compatibility)
- 129. Best Combination over 14hh (horse and rider compatibility)
- 130. Pleasure Mount under 14hh
- 131. Pleasure Mount over 14hh
- 132. Encouragement Award (awarded at judge's discretion may or may not be ridden)
- 133. Sports person award (awarded at judge's discretion) may or may not be ridden

- 140. Open competition min 70cm
- 141. Rescue Relay
- 142. Open 6 Bar
- 143. Open Hunter

Classes 6 & 7 will only be run if sufficient competitors.
