WOOL BREEDS RULES

- 01. Only 1 entry per person per section.
- 02. All sheep must be disease and vermin free. Stewards may order the removal of diseased or infected sheep from the show-grounds.
- 03. All sheep exhibited must be bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- 04. Where competition is restricted to less than two sheep in any one class, the judge is absolved from the necessity of awarding.
- 05. All entries to be staged by 9:00am.

PRIME LAMB RULES

- 01. Only 1 entry per person per section.
- 02. All prime lambs to be judged on commercial value, except where otherwise stated.
- 03. All lambs must be disease and vermin free.

 Stewards may order the removal of diseased or infected sheep from the show-grounds.
- 04. No lamb may be entered in more than one class, other than Championships.
- 05. Should a judge consider a lamb has been entered in a wrong class, he/she may shift the entry to the appropriate class and alter the steward's hook accordingly.
- 06. For judging of championships, all first prize winning pens of two or three are eligible.
- 07. All entries to be in pens by 9:00am.
- 08. Competitors must hold own lambs, or make arrangements to provide their own handlers.
- 09. All lambs exhibited must be bona fide property of the exhibitor.
