2. Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 25 th November 2025 and Extraordinary Meeting Monday 8 th December 2025 were approved and signed by the Chairman and Secretary as a true account.		Com

Booking Officer's Report Hallmaster online Booking System – Standard Conditions of Hire, Information for Hirers, Booking Form already circulated to full committee were agreed. 2-week extension of free rollout had been secured. Bookings up until April are already on the system. HS and LA to discuss invoicing further. Agreed Post Office hiring remains free as a service to the Community. Tennis Club hire fees to remain unchanged. Discussed cancellation terms of one-off hires and agreed deposits not refunded for cancellation within 0 – 14 days but offer of rebooking, within 15 – 31 days 50% deposit returned. £100 deposit children's parties, £150 for adult parties, £200 over 100 people party style – unanimously agreed. Lost keys - £10 deposit not returned to cover cost of a new key. Thanks to HS and LA for all their hard work in setting up this system.</p> <p>Community Payback - request from Parish Council for toilet access on Saturdays (January and February) to facilitate Fleggburgh churchyard tidying, as there are no toilets onsite (unlike at Clippesby Church). Discussed Committee being told that 'if under 23s were playing football they would not attend to carry out such work'. On that basis agreed unanimously that there was a perceived safeguarding risk to unsupervised children on the Playing Field or the Children's play area. <p>Health and Safety: Overhead barrier (car park main entrance) Keith Osborne and Lee Keeler were thanked for repairing the height nudge bar on 18/12/25.</p> <p>Buildings: Roof repairs completed on 19th December by RC Ryan Roofing – box gully above middle cupboard and replacing step flashing which caused leak above Music cupboard. Continue to monitor if there are any leaks in Main Hall roof closely and plan long term for when felt might need to be replaced.</p> <p>Heating – as per Draft Finance and General Purposes Minutes 6th January 2026 already circulated. Await quote to potentially update control panel - Powrmatic boiler Main Hall. Thanks were given to Keith Osborne for contacting new contractor. Issue with rotten wooden supports in compound to be investigated further.</p> <p>Car park extension – await planning meeting decision 21st January 6:30. JO advised quote from Josh Brooks for 35 concrete bollards installed around the edge approximately £5,000. Await drainage quote, once conditions being imposed along with approval of the application are received. JP reminded that S106 monies might be available to support the car park extension funding.
