From Ithaca

Take Route 13 North. (Route 13 North is called Dryden Road north of Ithaca.)

Go by Sciencenter, Ithaca City School District, and Boynton Middle School.

Go under North Triphammer Road.

Go by Sapsucker Woods Road, Hanshaw Road, New York State Electric & Gas, and New York State Police.

After Finger Lakes Dermatology PLLC and Scottie's Auto Repair, look for George Road on left side.

Make left turn onto George Road (Right side of road is called Irish Settlement Road.)

Church is on right side.

Parking is in front. Please enter via front doors.

From Cortland

Take Route 13 South.

Go by Advance Auto Parts, Best Western Plus, Essex Structural Steel Co., Inc., and Dollar General

Continue straight through traffic signal on Route 13 South.

Go by McDonald's.

Proceed into Dryden.

At intersection with traffic light, make right turn to continue on Route 13 South.

Go by library, Dryden Agway, and American Legion.

Make right turn onto George Road. (Left side of road is called Irish Settlement Road.)

Church is on right side.
