## Overview:

The same content will be covered at home as in person at Book Hooks. However, all the assignments will be completed at home. I will continue to work with students at their level and give personalized feedback on their assignments and specific individualized writing instruction. All assignments will be posted on Spark and any handouts will be attached to be printed at home. We will do a weekly zoom meeting to discuss novels and history topics. The discussion topic will be posted for each week. In addition, students will be a part of a Group Me discussion group where weekly questions will be posted for them to respond in a group. Last, I will individually work with each student on developing 4-6 projects for personal research and in depth learning on a topic of their choice. These projects can relate to a science or a history topic. Some possible projects could be:

- Write a fictional story based on historical events
- Construct a 3D model of a scene from history
- Learn the science in cooking that connects with a Chemistry topic being studied
- Build a structure that connects with a physics topic being studied
- Research a specific group or person and create a slide show, video, or report about the topic
- Learn a handicraft from a specific time period in American History and create a finished project: this could be cooking, knitting, sewing, woodworking, blacksmithing, or any other skill the student can connect to their learning.
- Investigate the scientific discoveries that occurred during the Early American History time period.
- Create an art/musical piece that ties to the history or science concepts.
- Create a podcast that ties in with content.

Students in the Greater Houston area will be invited to participate in our Fun Friday activities, and they will have access to check out books from our school library.
