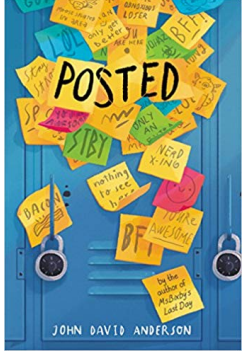


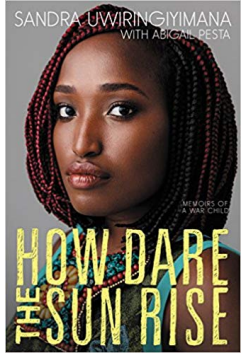
Racine-Kenosha English Festival 2019-20

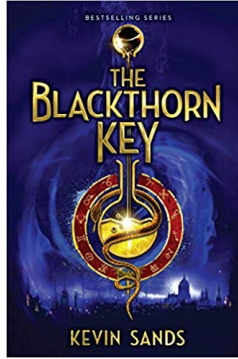
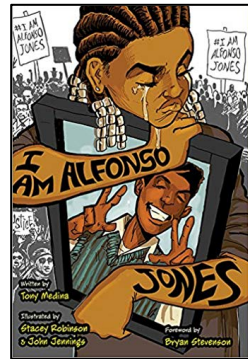
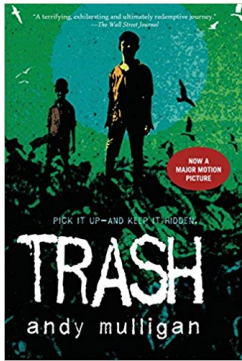


This year's Racine-Kenosha English Festival will be held at Carthage College, and the keynote speaker is John David Anderson, the author of *Posted*.
