<u>7 steps to guide you:</u>

1. Seek God Through Prayer and Fasting

Scripture: "Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know." —Jeremiah 33:3

Spend intentional time with God, asking Him to reveal His purpose for your life. Fasting can help quiet distractions and amplify spiritual clarity.

2. Study God's Word

Scripture: "Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path." —Psalm 119:105
The Bible is full of examples of God calling His people. Dive into scripture to understand how God speaks and leads.

3. Reflect on Your Gifts and Passions

Scripture: "We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us." - Romans 12:6

What are you naturally good at? What burdens or excites you? Often, God places clues to your assignment within your gifts and passions.

4. Identify the Burdens on Your Heart

Scripture: "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor." —Luke 4:18

What injustices or needs in the world deeply move you? These burdens may indicate where God wants to use you.

5. Serve and Take Action

Scripture: "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord." — Colossians 3:23

Start serving where you are. Many discover their assignment while in action, as God directs the steps of those who move in faith.

6. Seek Godly Counsel and Confirmation

Scripture: "Plans fail for lack of counsel, but with many advisers they succeed." — Proverbs 15:22

Share what you believe God is calling you to with trusted spiritual mentors or friends. They can offer wisdom, guidance, and confirmation.

7. Embrace God's Timing and Trust the Process

Scripture: "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens." —Ecclesiastes 3:1

God's timing is perfect. Stay patient and obedient, even if things don't unfold as quickly as you'd like.
