Parent's Agreement Statement

This document serves as an indicator to parents and the NCA board and staff that we agree in:

- The need for regular communication between parents, teachers, staff, board members and other parents. By signing it, the parents understand that, within the best of their ability, they will meet their obligation to attend meetings, such as parent teacher conferences, fund-raising meetings, and parent prayer meetings.
- The need for consistent prayer. The undersigned parents recognize that praying for the school, its students, teachers and special events, is one of the best ways to gift the school.
- The need to teach our children to be respectful of authority, to have a cheerful attitude and to serve the Lord Jesus.
- The need to meet financial obligations, on time. The school has a very small budget, and, if you don't pay, then the teachers don't get paid.
- The need for practical help. There is cleaning, painting, substituting, and many other things that parents can do. The current expectation is a minimum of 4 hours monthly for each family.
- The need for honest support. In the face of conflict, there is usually more than one side to the story. We expect that the parents will understand this and seek gentle resolution, not blame. The undersigned parents will agree not to discuss the problem with other parents, church members or other students, keeping it confidential, until the people directly involved have been contacted, and, if necessary, the board becomes involved.
- The need for agreement. The undersigned parents have read, and agree with the Policy Manual and the Statement of faith, and will not undermine this teaching in any way. The board also has the full discretion regarding the grade placement of each child.
- The need for separation. There are, unfortunately, times when a student's behavior or consistent attitude necessitates that we dismiss the child from the school. Similarly, there can be disruption caused to the school by a parent or family. This may also require separation.
- The need to seek the special educational needs of the student. As stated in the Admissions Policy, the parents and the student need to be aware of the probationary status of the acceptance to attend NCA. Periodically parents, teacher, and 1 or 2 board members will meet together to assess the behavior and academic success or troubles. If the educational needs are beyond NCA's ability to meet, separation may be required.
