**RESPONDENT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO FILE EXCEPTIONS AND RECOMMENDATION**

Respondent Andrew Ndubisi Ucheomumu ("Respondent"), *pro se*, files this *Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Exceptions and Recommendations* pursuant to Md. Rule 19-728(b), and in support thereof, respectfully states as follows:

1. On April 25, 2018, the Clerk of this Court received the record of the above-captioned proceeding transmitted by the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County pursuant to Md. Rule 19-727(g).
2. In the April 25, 2018 notice, the Clerk of this Court advised that oral argument in this matter will be scheduled during the October 2018 session.
3. On May 4, 2018, Petitioner Attorney Grievance Commission of Maryland ("Petitioner") filed a motion for extension of time to file exceptions and recommendation (the "May 4th Motion") seeking an extension of the deadline for it to file same until May 21, 2018.
4. On May 8, 2018, this Court granted the May 4th Motion.
5. Respondent was away, without access to email, until May 15, 2018 and did not receive notification about the May 4th Motion or the Hearing Judge's opinion until his return.
6. Given the current oral argument schedule and the Respondent's other obligations, he

contacted Petitioner's counsel on even date herewith proposing to extend the deadline for filing exceptions and recommendations until July 15, 2018. *See Exhibit 1.*


7. Petitioner's counsel informed Respondent that she still intends to file her exceptions and recommendations on May 21, 2018, but that she does not oppose the Respondent's proposed extension of the schedule. *Id.*

8. As such, Respondent proposes that the deadline for the parties to file exceptions and recommendations, pursuant to Md. Rule 19-728(b), be extended until July 15, 2018.

9. The requested extension will not otherwise delay the Court's consideration of this matter or its final disposition pursuant to Rule 19-729(c).

WHEREFORE, Respondent respectfully requests that this Honorable Court enter an Order extending the deadline for the parties to file exceptions and recommendations until July 15, 2018.


