

2021 League Rules

Welcome to the 2021 Glacier Club Mens Tuesday Team Golf League. This is our 8th season as a Team League and the Board of Directors wishes all members to have a fun and successful golf season. We welcome 11 new members this season. There are several important rule changes from 2020. Should you

Day and Time:	Day of play is Tuesday with the first tee time at 10:34 AM.
Play Dates:	The league plays all holiday weeks. No scheduled weeks off.
# of Teams:	The league consists of 19 two member teams. All members must be at least 55 years old. Since we have an odd number of teams this
Bye Week:	season, we will have a BYE week. Note the revised season schedule for your BYE week. You may play in all individual events. Since you are a twosome, feel free to contact a sub member or invite a friend as a fill-in. The friend wouldn't be eligible to enter the events.
Start Date:	Tuesday, May 04, 2021
Length of	The league plays 18 hole rounds for 20 weeks. The season is made up of 18 weeks of Team vs. Team competition, 1 BYE Week and Week
Season:	20 is the Position Finals Round. If we have no rainouts, the season will end on 9/14.
Weather Delays and Cancellation:	A weather delay or cancellation of play will be determined only by the Board of Directors. Please call the Glacier Club Golf Shop to verify the course conditions. Should the week be cancelled, this will be noted on the league website and an additional week will be added to the end of the season.
Suspended Play with Scoring Adjustments:	If play is suspended on account of weather, the Board of Directors will wait for 30 minutes to determine if play will resume. Please do not leave the golf course until a decision has been determined. If the round isn't resumed, the hole the last teed group completed will establish the complete round. All team matches, Skins, CTP and Low Net events will be closed upon said hole. All team points will be awarded thru said hole and all individual event winners will be paid from the entire weekly pot. There are no minimum holes.
	Teams will play for points in two events: (1) Team Modified Best Ball and (2) Team Individual Net Score.
Team Events and Fees:	The season entry fee for the Team Modified Best Ball and Team Individual Net Score events is \$100. A \$20 fee is assessed for administrative costs. The \$120 fee applies to only full time members, not to sub members.
Individual	Weekly Individual Handicap Skins - \$10 entry fee per player.
Events and	Weekly Individual Handicap Low Net Round - \$5 entry fee per player. See Statement of Fees for Payment.
Fees:	Weekly Individual Closest to the Pin - \$5 entry fee per player
Season Green Fees:	The season green fees for non - Glacier Club season pass holders are \$551 per member which includes the cart. We will play 20 weeks and pay for 19 @ \$29 per week. Range balls are extra. The green fees are paid directly to the Glacier Club Golf Shop and must be paid in full by May 04, 2021. If you don't play on your BYE week, you'll receive a Rain Check.
Handicaps:	All members must have an established handicap prior to the first week of play. All new members handicaps will be determined by the Board Handicap Committee. Returning members handicaps will be brought forward from previous years. The World Handicap System (WHS) governs all handicap calculations. Glacier Club in 2021 has re-indexed the golf course and most hole handicaps have changed. We will start the season using your 2020 handicap. We'll play the first 4 weeks to establish your 2021 handicap and start using them on

Scoring:

White Tee: Senior Tees:

> All members must count their total strokes per hole. The nature of our competition requires that all strokes be counted until your ball is holed. There are no maximum strokes and no pick-ups.

Week 5. Handicaps thereafter will be updated every two weeks and published within the league website.

The maximum handicap for the White Tees is 36.

The maximum handicap for the Senior Tees is 32.

Rules of Play:

PLAY ALL SHOTS DOWN - EVERYWHERE! (Exceptions stated below) USGA, Glacier Club and League Rules govern all play.

Putts:

NO GIMMIE PUTTS - PUTT EVERYTHING OUT! Please and Thank You.

Sand Traps:

Sand Traps: If a ball in a sand trap comes to rest in a foot print, rake or machine indentation, you must consult with your opponent to have it replaced. If he complies, rake the spot and replace your ball. No penalty.

Divots:

Fairway Divots: If your ball comes to rest in a divot in the fairway, you must consult with your opponent to have it moved. If he complies, you may drop one club length from the original ball. No penalty. This doesn't apply in the rough as a ball may not be moved in the rough. However should a ball, in the rough, come to rest under very unusual conditions, you must consult with your opponent to have it moved. If he complies, you may drop one club length, in the rough, from the original ball. No penalty.

Boulders:

Glacier Club Local Rule: Free drop if any large boulder interferes with your stance or swing. No penalty.

Ball on a Bridge:

Ball on Bridge: A bridge is part of the hazard. The ball may be moved back off the bridge and dropped with a 1 stroke penalty. You may also attempt to hit from the bridge.

White Tees

Play is from the White Tees except for qualified Senior Players. PLAY READY GOLF. Matches are to be completed in 4.5 hours.

Senior Tees (Hybrid Course) To qualify to play the Senior Tees you must be 70+ and have a handicap of 28+. This Hybrid Course is: The Par 3's are played from the White Tees, all the other holes are played from the new <u>Grey Markers</u>. The hybrid holes will be marked on your scorecard and also a description sheet will be available on May 04. Four (4) strokes will be deducted from your prior 2020 base handicap. Please let Mike Wise know 2 weeks prior to the start of the season if you wish to play the Senior Tees. Your tee declaration at the beginning of the season will be final for the entire season no matter the circumstances during the season.

Out of Bounds: Lost Ball: Hazards: OB or Lost Ball: Any ball that is hit out of bounds or presumed lost is to be played the same as a Lateral Red Stake Hazard rule. (Out of Bounds) With a 1 stroke penalty, drop within two club lengths from the point where the ball crossed the margin of the hazard. (Lost Ball) With a 1 stroke penalty, drop within two club lengths from the point where the ball is presumed lost. If there is any question as to where the ball entered the hazard or is lost, consult with your opponent to choose a drop location that is agreeable. <u>8th Hole</u>: A drive that is OB or lost to the <u>left</u> of the bridge, with a 1 stroke penalty, play from the drop area on the tee side of the hazard. A drive that is unplayable in the hazard, with a 1 stroke penalty, play again from behind the hazard. If an additional shot is unplayable in the hazard, with a 1 stroke penalty, play from the drop area on the green side of the hazard. <u>15th Hole</u>: A drive that is lost in the second and third ponds, with a 1 stroke penalty, play from the drop area that is located near the second pond. <u>16th Hole</u>: A drive that is unplayable in the hazard, with a 1 stroke penalty, play again from behind the hazard. If an additional shot is unplayable in the hazard, with a 1 stroke penalty, play from the drop area on the green side of the hazard. All other shots that end up in either Red or Yellow Hazards are to be played under USGA Rules.

Weekly Team

Events:

Each team consists of two members. The member having the lowest handicap is the "A" player and his partner is the "B" player. Each hole of the team match will be played team vs. team.

TEAM MODIFIED BEST BALL: Handicap Adjusted

One team net best ball will play against an opposing team net best ball. The team with the lowest net best ball (one ball) will win the hole and two points. Should there be a tie on any hole, each team will win 1 point.

TEAM INDIVIDUAL NET SCORE: Handicap Adjusted

The "A" member of each team and the "B" member of each team will oppose each other. This event is played in 2 formats; (1) The Net Score on the front 9 is determined by deducting your front 9 handicap from your front 9 gross score. The member with the lowest net front 9 will win 6 points. (2) The Net Score on the back 9 is determined by deducting your back 9 handicap from your back 9 gross score. The member with the lowest net back 9 will win 6 points. Should there be a tie on either of the 9s, each player will win 3 points.

Weekly Individual Events:

SKINS: Handicap Adjusted

Skins are handicap adjusted and you'll receive 100% of your strokes off of the lowest handicap player ball in play. Handicaps of 19 to 36 will receive two strokes on qualifying holes. The lowest handicap player will receive no skins strokes. To help eliminate ties on natural birdies, each handicap skin stroke will be figured @ .5 and the lowest net per hole will win the skin. Team members scoring a skin on the same hole will not cancel each other. The entry fee is \$10 per member. The winnings will be distributed every 2 weeks.

LOW NET ROUND: Handicap Adjusted

(Replaces the Progressive Low Gross Hole Event)

Low Net Round is handicap adjusted and you'll receive 100% of your handicap strokes. There are two flights, "A" with a handicap cap of 21 and "B" with a handicap of 22 and above. We will address these brackets after Week 4 when the new handicaps will be updated. There are 3 places paid in each flight. The entry fee is \$5 per member. The winnings will be distributed every 2 weeks.

CLOSEST TO THE PIN:

Tee ball on the Par 3s must be on the green. The entry fee is \$5 per member. The winnings will be distributed every 2 weeks.

Team Pairings: The 2021 season pairings will be published within the league website prior to the first week of play. Weekly pairings will be posted in the Golf Shop on the day of play and also published within the league website.

Team Points and Team \$ Pool: \$3800 Weekly team points will accumulate over the length of the season. The 2 lowest weekly team points for the season will be thrown out. The 1st lowest YTD team points will be thrown-out after Week #9 and the 2nd lowest YTD team points will be thrown out after Week #18. The Position Finals Round (Week #20) and BYE Weeks are not throw-outs. The first 8 teams with the most points will be the winners. The winnings pool is: 8th Place = \$200, 7th Place = \$275, 6th Place = \$350, 5rd Place = \$425, 4nd Place = \$500, 3rd Place = \$580, 2nd Place = \$670 and 1st Place = \$800. The winners will be paid during the season ending scramble event.

Sub Selection
Process:

The league has a mandatory sub platform. A sub member may be chosen no sooner than 1 (one) week prior to the date required. To select a sub, the absent member must contact the first sub member from the Sub Members Position List. If both members from a team are to be absent they must contact the first two subs from the list. If the first sub isn't available then the next one is to be contacted. If no subs are available, the team will play under the Absent Members rules. If the absent member chooses not to contact a sub, his playing partner will be assessed a handicap penalty of 20%. The Board understands that out of the ordinary circumstances may arise at the last minute. If a team has an absence on the day of play the 20% penalty will be waived. No team may have a sub on the Position Finals Round (Week #20). The absent member will receive a 2021 Rain Check from Glacier Club. The Sub Members Position List is a rotating process and its sequencing is published within the website on Page 3, Sub Members Detail. When a sub is chosen, the absent member must contact Mike Wise no later that Sunday PM prior to the week of play. Any member may have a long term sub (multiple weeks) for medical reasons. Please contact Mike Wise for further information. The sub's green fees of \$29 are payable to the Glacier Club. Sub members are eligible to play in all weekly event and the \$20 entry fee is payable to Mike Wise.

Absent Members: Should a member be unable to play and doesn't have a sub, his partner will play against the opposing team. The playing partner will represent both the "A" and "B" members in the team competitions. If both members of a team are unable to play and don't have any subs, they will receive "O" points. The opposing team will match cards to that of the absent team's prior week. No additional penalties will apply.

Unable to Finish Round: Should a member be unable to finish the round, his teammate may complete the round. Should both members of a team be unable to finish the round, their opposing team may complete the round and the remaining holes will be played matching the card of the withdrawn team's previous week. Should the entire match cease before finishing the round, points will be awarded to both teams thru the number of holes completed. No additional penalties will apply. If a team leaves the course without an illness or personal issue, they will lose all monies won during the round and the remaining points will be awarded by matching cards of the previous week.

Scorecards:

Weekly personalized scorecards will be in the Golf Shop League Box. The scorecard states the A & B members, the Starting Hole (#1 or #10) and each members handicap strokes regarding Team Best Ball, Skins and the Low Net Round events. Upon completion of play, compare your scorecards, sign and place them in the league box. Also place the CTP markers in the league box. Thank You!

Statements:

Please pay your events fees via Check or Apple Pay, no cash. Checks are payable to Mike Wise.

First Statement: The first Statement will be distributed on Week 1 (May 04) and will include the amount due for the Team Events @ \$120 and Weeks 1 thru 10 for the Individual Events @ \$200. Please pay the \$320 by May 11th. If you wish not to wait until the first week of the season, you may place your payment into the league box on my front porch. (Address is within the league website on the Website Facility Page).

Second Statement: The second statement will be distributed on Week 11 (July 13) and will include the amount due for Weeks 11 thru 20 for the Individual Events @ \$200 and any carryover credits that may apply. Please pay by July 20th. You may place your payment into the league box on my front porch. Thank You.
