

From the House Committee

Our clubhouse heater is nearly 30 years old. While it still provides some warmth, it is inefficient, noisy, and does not adequately heat the entire building—especially the back areas, which often remain cold.

After careful consideration, we have determined it is time to replace the unit with a modern system that will both heat and cool our building efficiently. We have obtained three estimates, with the lowest coming in at approximately \$15,000.

Thanks to generous early support—including \$100 donations from Black Oak Casino and the Sonora Area Foundation, along with funds raised through our Veterans Christmas Tree project—we are off to a great start.

Now comes the fun (and important) part: fundraising! We'll be writing grants, planning fundraisers, selling cupcakes—whatever it takes. Soon, members and friends will also be able to donate directly through our Zeffy account dedicated to this project.

If our foremothers could pay off this beautiful building in just a few years, surely we can work together to install a new HVAC system that will keep everyone comfortable for decades to come. So far, we've raised \$400—and we're just getting started! Thank you for your continued support of our clubhouse and our club.
