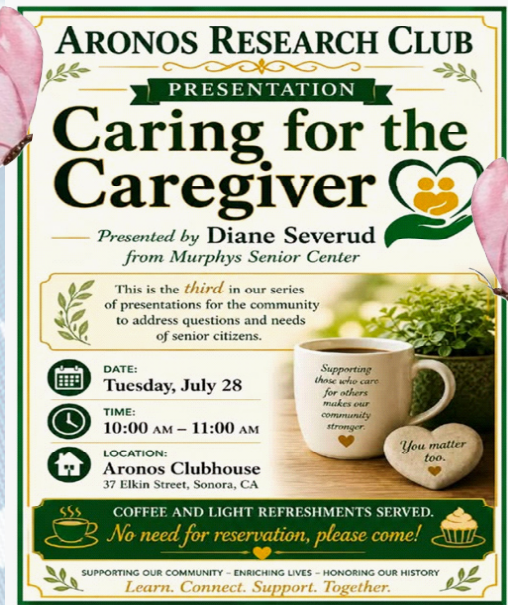

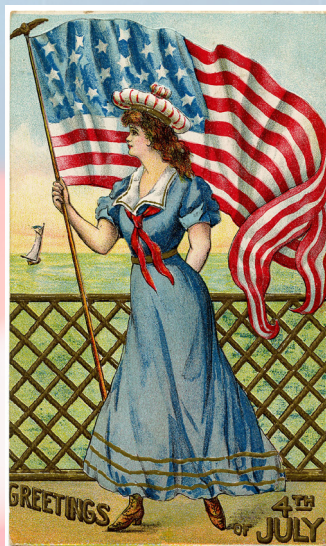
4th of July Grand Marshall in Columbia
