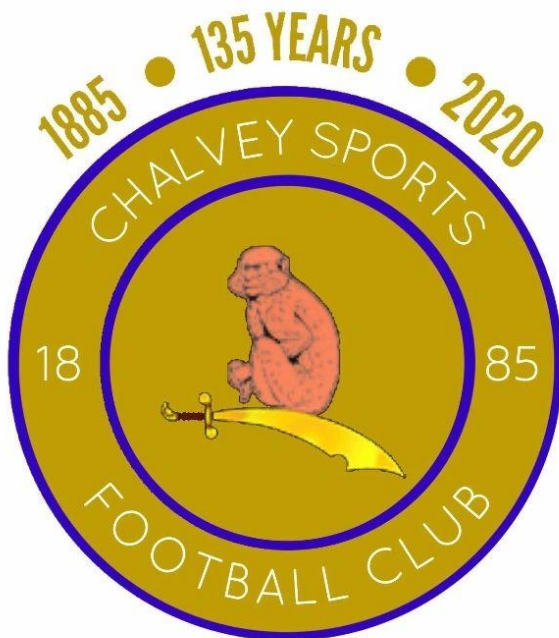


Chalvey Sports progress in the Challenge Cup
