

Student Dress Code Policy

Students attending classes at CTRTA are expected to dress appropriately for the training environment and the activities scheduled for each instructional day. Students should review the course syllabus for planned activities, including whether training will take place indoors or outdoors, in order to determine appropriate attire.

Safety is the primary consideration in selecting clothing for class and drill field activities. Comfort may be considered, but it must not take precedence over safety, professionalism, or appropriateness.

Minimum Dress Expectations

When dressing for warm weather, the following items are not permitted in classrooms or on the drill field:

- Short shorts.
- Tank tops.
- Open-toe shoes.
- Clothing with offensive wording, images, or artwork.

Students are expected to use common courtesy and professionalism in their choice of attire at all times. Clothing worn for drill field activities must be appropriate for the assigned activity, weather conditions, and season. CTRTA reserves the right to determine whether a student's attire is appropriate and may require a student to change clothing before participating in class or training activities.
