



WESTCHESTER COUNTY'S PREMIER COMMUNITY ORCHESTRA PLANS A PERFORMANCE AT THE OSSINING LIBRARY

Concertmaster Joanna Giordano leads the all-amateur orchestra in an hour-long concert of dramatic and light music.

WHITE PLAINS, NY (October 17, 2023) —The **New Westchester Symphony Orchestra** (NewWSO), under the leadership of its concertmaster Joanna Giordano, performs at the Ossining Library on Sunday November 5, 2023, 2pm. On the program are works by Mendelssohn, Coleridge-Taylor, Piazzolla, and Vaughan Williams.

Founded in 2011, NewWSO is dedicated to providing opportunities for Westchester County amateur instrumental musicians to gather, rehearse, and perform in standard orchestral repertoire. In a spirit of inclusivity and diversity, the orchestra welcomes (space permitting) all capable players to its ranks; there are no auditions. NewWSO primarily holds three large concerts each year, with additional appearances at smaller venues like the Ossining Library.

The performance takes place **2pm on Sunday, November 5, 2023, at the Ossining Public Library**, and is free and open to the public; children especially are welcome to attend. Collected donations to the orchestra are welcome. The event is supported in part by the Ossining Library, as well as the generosity of ArtsWestchester, Westchester Community Foundation, and other charitable organizations.
