AGENDA DISCUSSION

- George was thanked for all of his work on the front entrance
 - o Still dealing with messes left to us by Adams and Etheridge
 - o Still working on finding viable solar lighting for front entrance
- The HOA now has its own debit card for direct payments
- Dues: Last year's dues were @ 98% compliance, 2 non-compliance with the attorneys
 - O Currently are at 65%; 2nd notices will be sent out this week
- CC&R update: Did not happen last year, but it will happen this year
 - O Discussion on how we can get more response from homeowners
 - No real conclusive ideas on how to get more involvement; we have posted on Facebook, sent out physical notices; last call for suggestions resulted in zero responses
 - Discussed renters being involved via proxy; is covered in CC&R, but we have not had anyone use this option
- Budget: The HOA came in under budget last year. Slight increase to this year's budget because of increased postage costs for shipping the CC&R to homeowners
- Speed Survey no proof of speeders; damage to sensor on Raptor
 - City did take care of missing/incorrectly placed speed limit signs

- We are still on the city list for "Slow, Children at Play" sign installation, lower priority since Hurricane Michael
- Election of Board Members: President indicated that all current board members have agreed to stay on for another year. Motion made by Margaret Stewart to carry forward current board members, Kathy Hunley 2nd motion carried (none opposed)
 - Motion by Margaret Stewart to install Jesse Rodriguez as board member, Nettie Predieri 2nd and Jesse Rodriguez accepted

 - Motion by Margaret Stewart to install Kimberly Nilles as board member, Kathy Hunley 2nd and Kimberly Nilles accepted – motion carried (none opposed)
- Election of Officers current officers have all agreed to stay on another term
 - Motion made by Margaret Stewart that Wayne Smith remain Treasurer,
 Nettie Predieri 2nd, motion carried (none opposed)
 - Motion made by Margaret Stewart that Tina Herbert remain Secretary,
 Nettie Predieri 2nd, motion carried (none opposed)
 - Motion made by Margaret Stewart that Tom Emerick remain Vice President, Tina Herbert 2nd, motion carried (none opposed)
 - Motion made by Nettie Predieri that Margaret Stewart remain President, Kathy Hunley 2nd, motion carried (none opposed)

OPEN DISCUSSION

- Discussed the possibility of park being put in between Strike Eagle and Sidewinder
 - Currently land is "Green Zone", so we pay no taxes/insurance on it.
 Changing it to a park would require rezoning and we would have to start paying taxes on it
 - Park would also require insurance, ADA compliance, trash collection, upkeep which would have to be covered by the HOA dues (could increase them significantly)
 - Will check into some preliminary numbers to see if it would be worth doing
