

Media and mass shootings: odd bed fellows

Abstract



Journalist students should learn how to cover mass shootings, even if the mass shootings are in a different country 8000 kilometres away. New Zealand media may be adding to the problem. Psychologists have long begged the media to tread carefully when covering mass shootings. Their contagion effect theory posits that many mass shooters aim for high-publicity suicide, and they are copy-catting previous high-media shootings; thereby posthumous media publicity encourages others to plan similar mass shooting rampages. Psychologists want the media to highlight the photo of the victims, not the shooter, and to avoid using the shooter's name in the headlines. With more than 350 mass shootings a year in the United States, it is worth trying to limit the deaths, but are the media heeding this call? A recent mass shooting at a video game pub in Florida got global coverage, and this research showed some media earned high marks while others got failing marks in how they covered it responsibly.

We analysed 579 media headlines and photo selections. This included 469 hard-copy USA newspapers; 18 hard copy Oceania newspapers; and 92 online news sites.

Instead: highlight victims.





Journalists: too many mass shootings to rewreat cover, select most newsworthy

Rampage Shooters ramp it up to get publicity

Case Study: Jacksonville Video Game Mass Shooting

Al 579l Media covered it in some way




97% newspapers ran the story, half on the front page. But most omitted name/photo from frontpage

Photo on front page






Name in front page headline





Online story treatment (homescreen)





















Gamer gunman David Katz was hospitalised for psychological issues

Man had "significant" medical needs which resulted him undergoing psychiatric treatment.



Jacksonville gunman David Katz was an eSports champion who 'kept to himself'

The suspect was described as someone who kept to himself.

This includes NZ news sites – remember newspaper version omitted featurising him



Seconds from death: Footage shows laser on gamer before he was shot by David Katz

Witness said David Katz got mad after losing, returned and started 'blasting everybody'.



Interesting note from this content analysis of 500+ news stories

- none of the media called him a terrorist or madman..... it was gunman or shooter.
- Profile of mass shooters, especially a rampage shootes is Male, white, in 20s, not politically active, socially aloof, often described later as "just good old boys gone bad".



Conclusion



Unknown: how strong is the contagion effect theory.

Deaths rising from mass shooting rampages, so media should help.

Legacy media acting responsibly (especially newspapers). Online news outlets are not; even those associated with the legacy media companies.

Further Research: Why the NZ media's self-imposed ban on reporting suicide details doesn't apply to overseas mass shootings





Recommendation to Journalism Educators

Alert students to the media's involvement in mass shootings

Often the digital copy tasting for influencial online news is being done by younger journalists with less experience in media-ethical discussions.
