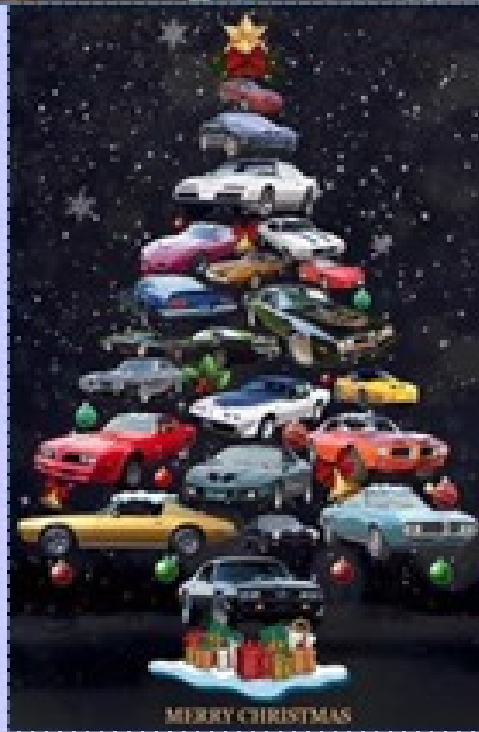

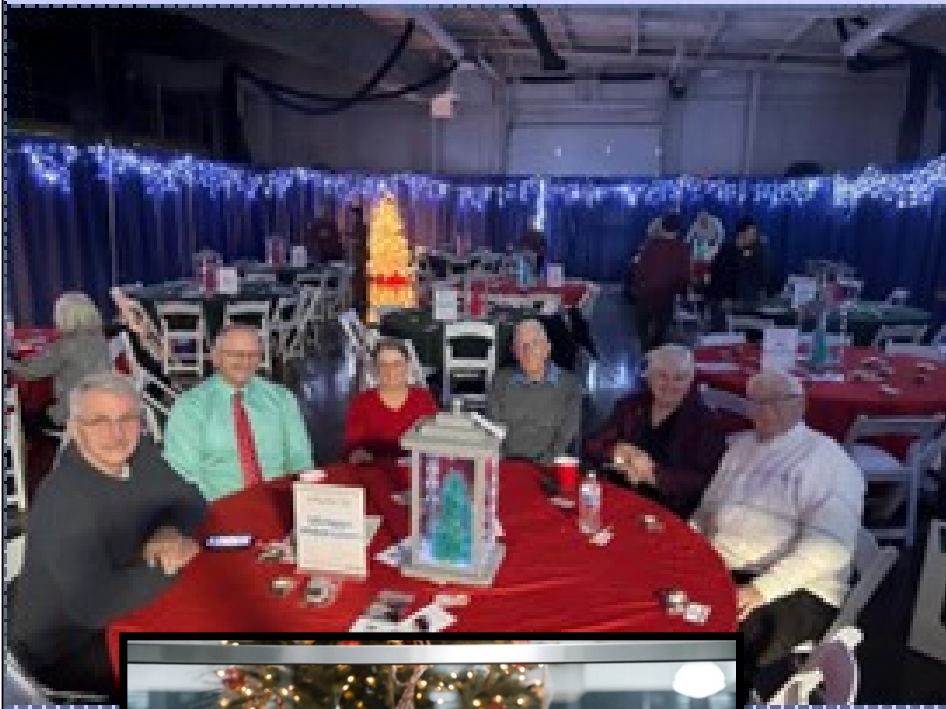
**In keeping with Diana's wishes, cremation services have been entrusted to Muir Brothers Funeral Home, Lapeer. There will be no formal service.**

### MICHIGAN WIDETRACKER'S SCHOLARSHIP

#### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS, RULES, AND INFORMATION

#### CURRENT PAID CLUB MEMBERS or SURVIVING SPOUSE MAY SPONSOR A CHILD/GRANDCHILD, STEPCHILD/GRANDCHILD IN THE SCHOLARSHIP DRAWING PROVIDING THE INFORMATION BELOW:

1. The applicant is the child, grandchild, or stepchild/grandchild of a Michigan Widetrackers Club Member who has been in good standing with the club for a minimum of 12 months.
2. The applicant (student) must provide:
  - a. Proof of acceptance or attendance from either a two- or four-year accredited institution or an accredited vocational school, and the applicant must enroll for full-time (12 hours or more) study under that school's requirements for the academic year.
  - b. A completed scholarship application
  - c. At least one letter of recommendation with their application from an unrelated person.
  - d. The applicant must include a current transcript up to Grade 12, including GPA. A current transcript is required if the applicant is enrolled in post-secondary education.
3. All applicants must include an essay of at least 200 words, not to exceed 500 words, on why they should be granted this scholarship.
4. The Michigan Widetrackers Scholarship will be awarded only once, and the winner is not eligible to reapply.
5. Payment will be made directly to the recipient's school of choice, c/o the applicant's name, via a check from Michigan Widetrackers for \$500.00 for any educational need.
