## Nurse Assistant Training (CNA Day Program)

- A Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA) is responsible for assisting patients with activities of daily living (ADL) tasks. Nursing Assistants provide important basic nursing care services to their resident and or patients.
- CNA's work under the supervision of a Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN) or Registered Nurse (RN). They serve as a conduit between patients, nurses, and doctors. CNA's also record vital information and communicate all issues to nursing staff.
- They play a valuable role to the health care profession. Training includes 60-hour Theory lecture and 100-hour clinical skills, with lab integrated in the program.

### **Enrollment Requirements**

- Registration/Application fee \$300.00 (forms available on pick up at front desk or by e-mail)
- 16 years of age or older
- CPR certification (B.L.S through American Heart Association)
- Government issued Identification card or Driver License
- Health & Physical examination (current within 90 days starting the program)
- Immunization Record
- TB Test or Xray if needed or QuantiFERON (current within 1 year)
