My Catholic education has helped me modify my personal values to help myself be the best person I can be. I will explain four of some of my most important personal values, and some of the ways those values helped me.

I don't go on Youtube unless I need to for school, and I only use social networking for my violin lesson. I also do not do any drugs whatsoever. I want to protect my body and not abuse it. My Catholic education made me realize the importance of taking care of my body and mind.

My fourth value is to try to limit my screen time. I try to play outside instead of playing video games. I try to build towns with legos or blocks or practice a musical instrument instead of looking at a screen. I try to make things instead of having them made for me. I realize I should use my imagination instead of using a screen. I think those other activities are much more productive. My Catholic education helps me use my mind instead of a piece of plastic.

Those are some of my most important personal values. I think they help me become a better son and a better Catholic.
