

Method

1. As well as dried flowers and grasses and Dypro Multi-Purpose Dyes in your choice of colours, you'll need a plastic bowl, rubber gloves, a glass jug, a stirring utensil and paper towels.
2. Wearing rubber gloves, dissolve correct amount of dye (see reference chart) in 500ml of very hot water.
3. Wet dried flowers or grasses completely and then submerge in bowl. Gently move them around bowl to make sure all areas are covered.
4. Remove dried flowers from solution once desired colour is achieved. Rinse carefully and allow to dry by laying them on paper towels.
5. During drying process, tap dried flowers or grasses gently to separate.

Note: The quantity of dye needed depends on the depth of colour required. The shades obtained will not be as intense as those achieved on dyed fabric.

Colour Number / Amount of Dye Powder to Use Per 500g/1lb of Fabric:

Amount of Dye Per 500g/1lb of Fabric	10g	12g	16g
