

Dypro Multi-Purpose Dye: DRIED GRASSES

Method

- As well as dried flowers and grasses and Dypro Multi-Purpose Dyes in your choice of colours, you'll need a plastic bowl, rubber gloves, a glass jug, a stirring utensil and paper towels.
- Wearing rubber gloves, dissolve correct amount of dye (see reference chart) in 500ml of very hot water.
- 3. Wet dried flowers or grasses completely and then submerge in bowl. Gently move them around bowl to make sure all areas are covered.
- 4. Remove dried flowers from solution once desired colour is achieved. Rinse carefully and allow to dry by laying them on paper towels.
- 5. During drying process, tap dried flowers or grasses gently to separate.

Note: The quantity of dye needed depends on the depth of colour required. The shades obtained will not be as intense as those achieved on dyed fabric.

Colour Number / Amount of Dye Powder to Use Per 500g/1lb of Fabric:
